The White Rock Wind Farm team would like to provide an update on recent works at the project site.

On-site construction activity

The following works are continuing in the Matheson locality:

- Final works on the access road from Gwydir Highway to the main construction compound.
- Final works on the upgrade to Ilparran Road.
- Delivery of turbine components
- Reinforcement and concrete pours of wind turbine foundations in preparation for the delivery and installation of turbine components.

Traffic implications near the project site

Site vehicles and heavy trucks delivering materials to site are regularly travelling the Gwydir Highway and accessing the site from the main northern entrance and also down Ilparran Road. Please take care when driving in these areas and also when passing site entrances.

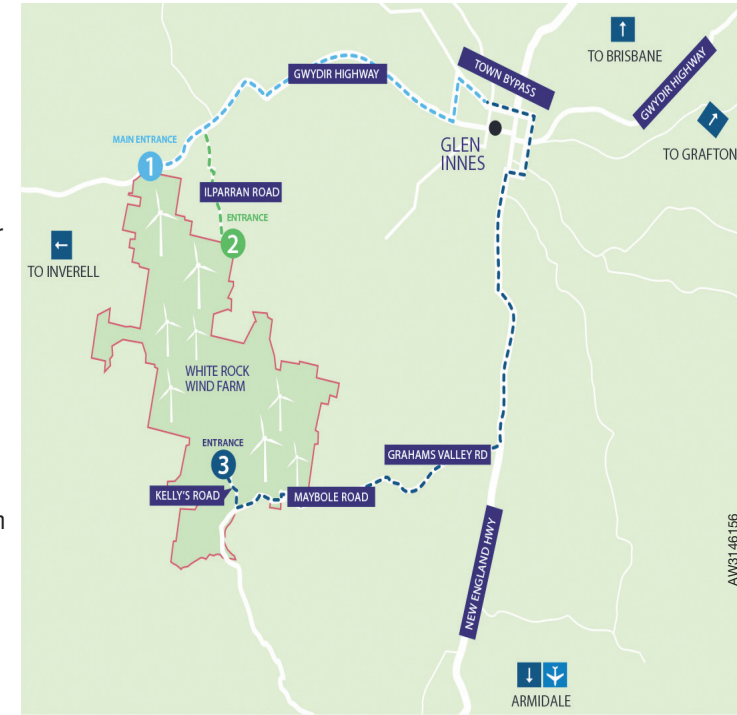
Please observe all warning and speed restriction signs.

Delivery of turbine components

Oversize vehicles transporting turbine components commenced deliveries on 5 December 2016. Approximately 700 oversize loads of turbine components will be travelling from Newcastle, via the New England Highway. These permitted and fully escorted loads will follow a set route and schedule. Near Glen Innes, the loads will be travelling the New England Highway to Heron Street, Hunter Street, Grafton Street, Martin Street, Strathbogie Road, Tuttles Lane, Gwydir Highway and Ilparran Road to the White Rock Wind Farm project site. Typically, the loads will travel through the outer township of Glen Innes midmorning on weekdays. Deliveries will cease for the holiday period from 14 December 2016, resuming on 4 January 2017.

Some deliveries will also cease from 20 to 29 January 2017 for the Tamworth Country Music Festival.

The White Rock Wind Farm team aim to keep local disruption to a minimum and apologises if construction activities cause you some inconvenience. Regular updates on construction activities, including what to expect on roads around the site during construction, will be provided in this paper, the White Rock Wind Farm Newsletter, White Rock Wind Farm website and radio broadcasts as the project progresses.
